Before calling any of these programs be prepared to discuss:

- o Dates of medical appointments
- o Financial need
- Medical necessity
- Accessibility needs
- o Information about a guest traveling with you
- O Ask about restrictions, changes in flights due to weather, and references

Important Notes

- All programs listed require patients to be medically stable, able to walk to board the plane, and able to sit up with a seatbelt on for the duration of the flight
- o You or your family are responsible for transportation to and from the airports

Financial need Must be able to fly in an un-pressurized plane Will provide flights as needed – no limit to children and adults Emergency flights are reserved for persons who need to visit critically ill or injured family members for patients needing organ transplants, or for organ donations 	One companion is allowed to travel with the patient. If space permits, two people are able to accompany
Corporate Angel Network To request flight call: 914-328-1313 www.corpangelnetwork.org	Arranges free air transportation to treatment centers, using the empty seats on corporate jets.	 Cancer patients, bone marrow donors/recipients, stem cell donors/recipients who can walk up the steps of corporate aircraft without assistance No financial need requirement Traveler does not require oxygen, IV medication, or medical assistance while onboard the plane May travel as often as necessary 	Caregivers may be able to accompany if space allows • Under 21 - two caregivers allowed • Over 21 - one caregiver allowed

Financial need Require a doctor's statement of medical stability Prefer at least one weeks' notice Prefer that patients are able to fly in unpressurized plane, however can accommodate if unable to 	One support person can accompany if space allows If space allows, both parents may accompany if a child under 18
