Richard A. Berger, MD is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Orthopaedic Surgery at Rush University, Chicago, IL. He specializes in complex joint reconstruction with the use of minimally invasive techniques.

Dr Berger is credited with developing minimally invasive hip and knee replacement. He pioneered outpatient joint replacement; having done the first outpatient THA in 2001, the first outpatient Uni in 2002, and the first outpatient TKA in 2003. Currently, Dr. Berger performs about 1400 minimally invasive hip and knee replacements per year, most of them on an outpatient basis.

Dr. Berger has published extensively on outpatient total hip and knee arthroplasty; designed many hip and knee replacements; and has developed many new approaches to total hip and knee arthroplasty.
