Spend your summer researching at Mass General Hospital with the MGH Center for Diversity and Inclusion!

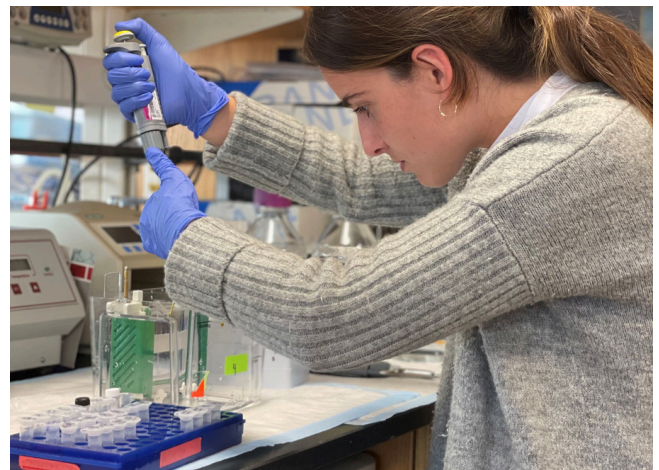

- Undergraduate junior or senior; rising first-year medical student; first-year medical student; graduate-school student; or post-baccalaureate student
- Attended/attending college, graduate school, or medical school in the U.S. and Puerto Rico.
- U.S. citizen or permanent resident.
- Completed application with personal statement, resume/CV, photo, and two letters of recommendation and all required transcripts.
- Commit to working exclusively at Mass General during SRTTP with full availability for the entire SRTTP duration.
