She has led opioid overdose prevention initiatives in many different settings, including working at the Philadelphia Department of Public Health to create a citywide naloxone training program in partnership with community organizations in overdose "hotspot" neighborhoods across the city. She is passionate about community health and health equity, and plans to practice a mix of primary care, addiction medicine, and public health after residency.
