### **Warning Signs of Unsafe Driving**

- · Difficulty seeing at night, dusk, or dawn
- Difficulty keeping up w/ speed limit
- Being intimidated by passing vehicles
- · Easily distracted while driving
- Difficulty seeing police officer on detail
- Difficulty following detours
- Getting lost on once familiar roads
- Scratches, dings, dents or near misses

## Regulate/Limit Driving

- Self-Imposed limits
- Drive familiar roads
- Avoid driving at night
- Avoid high traffic hours
- · Avoid mobile devices while driving

# **Professional Driving Evaluations**

- Hospitals and Rehabilitation Centers
- Out-patient basis
- Cost \$200 \$700
- May share results with RMV
- Money well spent if it prevents a crash, injury, and/or death

### **RMV Competency Road Test - costs \$35**

- Request for Medical Evaluation form [links to a pdf]

- Requested by health care provider or license holder
- Submit form to RMV Medical Affairs Bureau
- May result in loss of license; request for Competency Road Test at RMV: or a limited or full licensure.
