## **Admission Process**

## **Eligibility Requirements**

- Graduate of a CAPTE accredited PT program or the equivalent (as evidenced by eligibility for state PT licensure)
- Currently licensed in the state of Massachusetts or license-eligible in Massachusetts by of the start of the clinical portion of the program (early September)
- Meets all eligibility requirements to be employed as a practicing physical therapist within MGH PT Services
- Completed a minimum of 10 weeks of clinical experience in a neurologic setting either as PT student or as a licensed PT

## **Application Process**

Submit application through RF-PTCAS (<a href="https://rfptcas.liaisoncas.com/applicant-ux/#/login">https://rfptcas.liaisoncas.com/applicant-ux/#/login</a>) by January 20, 2025, including:

- An official transcript from each PT college and university attended for those with less than 5
  years of clinical practice.
- Curriculum Vitae
- Three letters of recommendation at least one of which must be from a clinical supervisor
- Answers to the following questions:
  - What do you value in a residency program? How does our program align with your values? Why is a residency right for you at this point in your career?
  - Describe the depth and breadth of your experience working with neurologic patients.
  - What specific character traits do you possess that make you an ideal candidate for this residency program?
  - What are your three to five-year professional goals? How do you hope our residency will help you achieve those goals?

Select candidates will have an in-person or virtual interview.
