FOR PARENTS, CAREGIVERS AND FAMILIES

Throughout Aspire's programming, success is measured by individual goals and personal achievements. Aspire staff communicate participants' progress in a variety of ways. During the summer session, parents can expect the following:

- Virtual orientation for caregivers and families prior to the start of camp
- · 'Camp Open House' for campers and their famiiles at Hale prior to the start of camp
- Pre-camp introductory phone call to meet the group leader and discuss personal goals
- Daily progress notes from camp

• Mid-session phone conference with group leaders to discuss progress toward individual goals and review helpful

- supports and strategies used at camp
- Weekly virtual caregiver groups facilitated by Aspire's Child Program Manager.
- End of camp summary which includes a review of progress made toward personal goals; an evaluation of skills within Aspire's core curriculum (i.e., social competency, stress management and self-awareness); and the most useful strategies/methods used to support skill-building during programming.
